Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner

The first indicator of a vibrant parish is under the heading of "Vision and Leadership."

The Diocese of Erie offers four main points:

The parish follows and promotes the Gospel of Jesus Christ and understands its relationship to the diocese and universal church.

The parish develops a local vision for pastoral activity in the coming years which is rooted in the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The parish is staffed by properly trained ministers or shares staff with other parishes to lead and direct all areas of the parish's mission.

The parish has a finance council and a pastoral council in place, which meet regularly to engage and involve the faithful to help carry out the pastoral activity of the parish.

*Notice that the first point is about the Gospel and the parish's relationship to the diocese and universal church. The Gospel is the parish's heartbeat and provides the parish's vision. Also, the parish is not an isolated entity. Instead, the parish has a relationship with the diocese and the universal church.

*The second point is crucial, practical,

and relevant. Although the Gospel provides the overarching vision, each parish needs a local vision that is oriented toward the particular needs, concerns, and challenges of its community. This vision then overflows into every ministry offered by the parish.

*The leading and directing of the parish mission demand an excellent staff.

Notice that the indicator assumes (as it should) that only ministers "lead and direct all areas of the parish's mission."

A vibrant parish is a team effort.

*Like the previous indicator, the finance and pastoral councils assist the pastor and the assisting clergy. A vibrant parish is a team effort.
