Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner



Chapter 6 of Brandon Vogt's book "RETURN" discusses the importance of equipping oneself. This is probably my favorite chapter in the book because it challenges us to know our faith.

He discusses how important it is for us to know the Bible and the Catechism of the Catholic Church. I find it interesting that his first two recommendations reflect the approach of Fr. Mike Schmitz.

As you may know, Fr. Schmitz released "The Bible in a Year" podcast in 2022. His podcast for 2023 has been "The Catechism in a Year." The Bible. The Catechism. We must know these well.

I highly recommend trying out these two podcasts. For those of you who have followed Fr. Mike Schmitz's podcasts, I want to take a moment to encourage you...keep going, keep up the good work.

I remember in college meeting several young people who really knew the Catholic faith. They were kind, humble, and intelligent students. I was impressed with their worldviews. Their examples really motivated me.

I began to read more about the Catholic faith while in college. I watched hundreds of Bishop Robert Barron YouTube videos. I read several books from Archbishop Fulton Sheen and listened to several of his talks. I began reading Pope St. John Paul II's works. I also got involved in Campus Ministry.

I'm not really sure if I would be a priest if it weren't for those young, equipped Catholics that I had met at St. Vincent College. It's quite remarkable how much fruit comes from the example of an equipped Catholic.

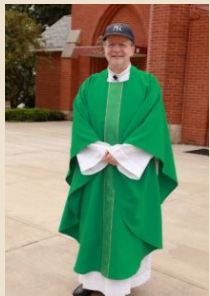
