

Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner



Last week I reflected on the first paragraph of "The Hobbit." We saw that Bilbo preferred the hobbit hole approach to life because of fear.

While Bilbo Baggins is minding his own business in his hobbit hole, he hears a knock on the door. Gandalf, a remarkable wizard, says to Bilbo, "I am looking for someone to share in an adventure that I am arranging, and it's very difficult to find anyone."

How often in life, while we are minding our own business in our little worlds, a unique opportunity arrives at the door of our hearts? (Think of Jesus saying to Simon and Andrew while they were fishing, "Come, follow me.")

What is our first instinct during these encounters? Do we push them away or do we give them a chance?

The person who is consumed in the hobbit hole pushes opportunities away and closes the door on possibilities. Simon and Andrew "immediately dropped their nets" and followed Jesus.

Unfortunately, Bilbo Baggins doesn't have the same response as the Apostles. Bilbo responds to Gandalf's invitation, "We are plain quiet folk and have no use for adventures."

Such is the soul stuck within the self (the hobbit hole). Bilbo avoids the opportunity and the adventure. Yet, something deep within him is slowly starting to be stirred. Will he allow this opportunity to pass him by?


Pipe Organ Concert at St. Catherine Sunday, September 17, at 2 p.m.

All are welcome to enjoy a concert to celebrate the most recent improvements to the "Historic Hook and Hasting" pipe organ at St. Catherine of Siena Church. Under the direction of Stephen Paul Toney, the concert will feature members of both the Queen of the World Church, St. Marys, and St. Catherine Church with sacred music and organ solos. Stephen Paul has been restoring this magnificent organ, originally from Boston, Mass., for posterity for the past 14 years. It is the instrument he learned to play organ music, he said, and he has a special connection to this organ.

The most recent work done to this pipe organ was reinstalling the missing concussion bellows on the great division wind truck. He also restored the reeds on the organ which included the trumpet great division and coropean and oboe on the swell division. Most significantly, the work will bring the speech, or sound, of 1,737 pipes back to their original glory. There is no cost to attend. Please spread the word so many can attend.
