Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner

I have had several people ask me what I do in my free time (what are my hobbies). The answer to the question tells a lot about a person.

First of all, I schedule my free time. I believe that scheduling the time motivates me to actually use the time wisely (because there are many other important things that we could be doing with our time). Second, the free time must be offered to God with the intention that I return from the free time further motivated and renewed to work. Third, I don't have a television. I have not had a television for 12 years. Also, if there is something really worth watching, I'll find a television or use my iPhone. Fourth, I parallel task and have been practicing this technique for over a decade. Parallel tasking means doing two things at once. For example, running while listening to a podcast or hitting golf balls at the driving range while listening to an audio book or fishing with my younger brother and talking about anything.

Free time doesn't mean "I have time now to do whatever I want." Instead, free time demands that we humbly ask God, "How would you like me to prudently enjoy this free time to further glorify you?"

Of course, I have yet to actually answer the question. I like to exercise, read, golf, hike, write, call a friend, listen to good speakers, make/edit videos, and much more.
