Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner



We are now in the 5th Sunday of Lent. It's obvious that our readings, especially the Gospel, are beginning to have a Resurrection theme. There is a clear reason as to why we are focusing on the Resurrection. We must keep the main goal before our eyes.

Lent is not easy, it's difficult. Prayer, fasting, and almsgiving are hard work. If these were easy then everyone would consistently do them and not have to devote a season to them. The desert, so to speak, is not meant to be easy. Lent is a time of challenge, purgation, repentance, spiritual detoxing, and letting go of unnecessary attachments to this world. Lent ought to be hard, arduous, and difficult.

Now, let me return to our Gospel with this in mind. The Resurrection theme is crucial for this time of Lent. We need a reminder of our destination on this Lenten journey. How easy it is to forget about the end goal? How easy it is to become discouraged as a result? How easy it is to lose motivation? How easy it is to quit? Coaches know exactly what I am talking about. There are moments in the season when practices become repetitive, even monotonous. The successful teams keep their eyes on the end goal - a championship.

Lent is going somewhere. It has an end goal. We are moving toward Easter. The goal is an empty tomb. Resurrection. Heaven. Eternal life. Complete happiness.

I'd say that's worth training for in this 5th week of Lent.
