

Deacon Ben's Corner



I have had a few parishioners this summer ask me, "What do you think of the Church?" It is a great question and worth asking. It also leads us to my favorite quote. Pope Saint Paul VI (my role model by the way) wrote, "The Church exists in order to evangelize." He also stated that the Church doesn't have

missions but rather that the *Church is mission*. So, what do I think of the Church? The Church is a means to an end - Christ established the Church "so that everyone who believes in Him will not perish, but have eternal life" (John 3:16). The Church is not a human institution which solely focuses on worldly demands. Rather, the Church is the bride of Christ - She looks to Him, follows His commands, believes in Him regardless of the opposition seen in the world. I'd like to end this short reflection with the words of St. Boniface (The Apostle to the Germans), "In her voyage across the ocean of this world, the Church is like a great ship being pounded by the waves of life's different stresses. Our duty is not to abandon the ship but to keep her on her course." My thoughts on the Church are simply echoes of Pope St. Paul VI and St. Boniface.
