Deacon Ben's Corner

How I view the diaconate (being a deacon):



I immediately think of St. Lawrence who died in the year 258 in Rome. Lawrence was one of the deacons to Pope Sixtus II. Both Pope Sixtus II and St. Lawrence were martyred by the Roman Emperor Valerian. The death of St. Lawrence provides one of the greatest stories in Christian history.


The Romans demanded that Lawrence would take them to the "treasures of the Catholic Church." Of course, the Romans wanted to take the money from the treasury. Lawrence, instead, took the Roman soldiers and guards to the homeless, the widows, the fatherless children, the sick and the lame. He then said, "Here is the treasure of our Church." St. Lawrence was then martyred.

The deacon at a Catholic Mass always prays the intercessions rather than the priest. The intercessions are often prayers for the sick, the dying, etc. because it is the deacon whose office reaches out to the poor, the sick, the disabled. Notice in the St. Lawrence story above – he knew exactly where the poor and the sick were because he served.

The deacon, throughout Church history, has been the one to know the voice of the poor, their struggles, and their needs.

The moment I mistake the real treasure of the Church for anything other than "whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters of mine, you did for me" is the moment that I do not live up to the role of a deacon (Matthew 25:40).
