

Originally from the Diocese of Greensburg where he served as parochial vicar, pastor, assistant chancellor and vice-chancellor, as

Bishop Lawrence T. Persico went on to be appointed defender of the bond and advocate of the diocesan tribunal by Bishop Brandt. On October 1, 2012, he was ordained and installed as the 10th Bishop of the Diocese of Erie. 
