

# Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner

The fifth indicator of a vibrant parish is under the heading of "Stewardship and Building community."

The Diocese of Erie offers four main points:

- 1. The parish welcomes new parishioners and invites them to become involved in the parish mission.
- 2. Parishioners are invited and provided opportunities to better understand their gifts and talents and the ways these can be used to minister to others.
- 3. Parishioners understand stewardship as a response to their discipleship and give of time, talent, and treasure to support the Church's mission.
- 4. The parish fosters opportunities for fellowship providing a sense of community for parishioners.
- \*The first point demands that a vibrant parish brings in new people. It's not just the same group, different weekend.
- \*The second point accomplishes the first. How can we assist our parishioners in better understanding their gifts and talents?
- \*Which of these three (time, talent, treasure) is the Lord calling you to give?
- \*The fourth point means that the sign of peace is not sufficient for the only interactions among parishioners. There have to be more opportunities to engage one another, build friendships, for families to come together, for people of different generations to meet one another, etc. The communities of St. Bernard, St. Marys, St. Michael, Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and St. Catherine have unique ways of fellowship opportunities. How can these be brought into Holy Spirit Parish?

Currently the pastor of Saint Leo Magnus Catholic Church in Ridgway, PA, Fr. Pino has also served as Archivist and Historian for the Diocese of Erie since 2010. He holds the office of Vice-President for Catholic Mission of the Elk County Catholic School System. In addition, he is a member of the Board of Directors of the Elk County Historical Society. A native of

Coalport, Fr. Pino attended Glendale Public Schools and then entered Saint Mark Seminary and Gannon University in 1999. There he earned a Bachelor of the Arts in History with a Minor in Philosophy. He studied theology at Saint Mary's Seminary and University in Baltimore, Maryland – America's first Roman Catholic Seminary – from 2003 – 2007, when he was granted a Master of Divinity and a Baccalaureate in Sacred Theology. While in Baltimore Father Pino oversaw the restoration of the seminary's Rare Book Collection. He was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Erie on June 8, 2007.
