Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner

This is the last bulletin article of the Bilbo Baggins series during September. The last paragraph of the book (after Bilbo goes on an adventure and learns a tremendous amount about himself) depicts Gandalf and Bilbo speaking to one another outside of the hobbit hole.

Notice the key phrase "outside of the hobbit hole." Bilbo is no longer restricted in the hobbit hole. He has experienced the wider world, new opportunities, and a new way of seeing reality. He is now free and, as we will see, filled with gratitude.

Gandalf says to Bilbo, "You are a very fine person, Mr. Baggins, and I am very fond of you; but you are only quite a little fellow in a wide world after all!" Bilbo responds, "Thank goodness!"

Bilbo's response is of someone who has taken a step outside the hobbit hole (beyond one's comfort zone) and into the wider world of opportunity and adventure. It's the place of gratitude and the realization that we are built for something much greater than ourselves. Bilbo is no longer restricted by fear. He has been set free.

I highly encourage you to read "The Hobbit." It's a story about you and me, a story about a fearful soul who becomes a courageous soul.

There are three parts to the Hobbit story:

- #1 - too fearful to go on an adventure
- #2 - currently on an adventure
- #3 - reflecting on the adventure


