Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner

Today's Gospel reading challenges us with Christ's words, "For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be."

The word "treasure" and our English word "worship" have a unique connection. Our English word "worship" comes from the Old English "weorthscipe" which means "that which is of greatest worth" [worthship].

In other words, what is of greatest worth to us is what we worship

Jesus demands that He is of greatest worth to us. Yet, we know that we are often tempted to place something else in front of Him - of greater worth to us than Him. St. Thomas Aquinas identifies four great substitutes which we often choose instead of the real treasure - God. The substitutes are wealth, honor, power, and pleasure.

Again, we worship whatever is of greatest worth to us. It is precisely in having God as our greatest worth that wealth, honor, power, and pleasure find their proper places and are authentically expressed. It is also when we orient and direct wealth, honor, power, and pleasure toward God that we truly worship.

What is of greatest worth to us? The answer to that question indicates what we truly worship.


