

DuBois Roman Catholic Cemeteries Update

The DuBois Roman Catholic Cemetery Advisory Committee met for the second time on Thursday, June 13, 2019. This new committee was formed by Fr. Siefer to advise him regarding the four Roman Catholic Cemeteries owned by St. Catherine and St. Michael Churches. They are: St. Catherine West and East (former Oklahoma Cemetery), St. Michael and St. Joseph. The members of this committee are: Barry Miller, John Luchini, Kathy Ford, Barb Ross, Bill Young, Jerry McIntosh, Frank Kruse and Fr. Siefer. One of their first actions was to look at the cost of lots at our cemeteries. **Acting upon their advice, effective August 1, 2019, the cost for lots at each of the cemeteries will be \$350.00.** The current price at St. Joseph and St. Michael will remain at \$300.00 until July 31, 2019, at 3:00 p.m. They also approved By-Laws for the committee, the cemetery rules & regulations and some operational matters. We will keep you apprised of all future matters regarding our cemeteries. Thank you.
