

Fr. Ben Daghir's Corner

In review, the Diocese of Erie provides six indicators of a vibrant parish:

- 1.) Vision and leadership
- 2.) Worship and the sacraments
- 3.) Lifelong faith formation, Catholic education, and evangelization
- 4.) Service and pastoral care
- 5.) Stewardship and building community
- 6.) Administrative services

A vibrant parish demands the ministries of many people. It extends far beyond Sunday morning and impacts every day. It extends into the spheres of nursing homes, Catholic schools, hospitals, homes, the surrounding communities, and much more. It builds upon financial and administrative prudence.

A vibrant parish encourages and fosters vocations - and this goes far beyond a prayer during the intercessions at Mass. As my mother says, "Fostering vocations might mean an empty seat or two at the dinner table. It might mean no grandchildren. It will certainly come at a cost." If you are a mother or father reading this bulletin article, are you willing to foster a vocation at your dinner table?

A vibrant parish has parishioners who "are challenged to reach out to inactive Catholics, inquirers, the unchurched and others." Let me be clear, the vibrancy of Holy Spirit Parish (and every parish in the Diocese of Erie) will be measured according to this indicator. I am excited to see how we reach out beyond our church doors through effective, apostolic ways.

I conclude this series of bulletin articles with words from Bishop Lawrence T. Persico. In his letter "Building the Future: A Call to Embrace Renewal and Restructuring in the Diocese of Erie" he wrote, "I cannot emphasize strongly enough that although our structures may change, the mission Christ gave us to go forth and make disciples remains. As inspiring as that sounds, we all know it requires a great deal of sacrifice, generosity, and willingness to walk through challenges with the faith that Christ accompanies us."


