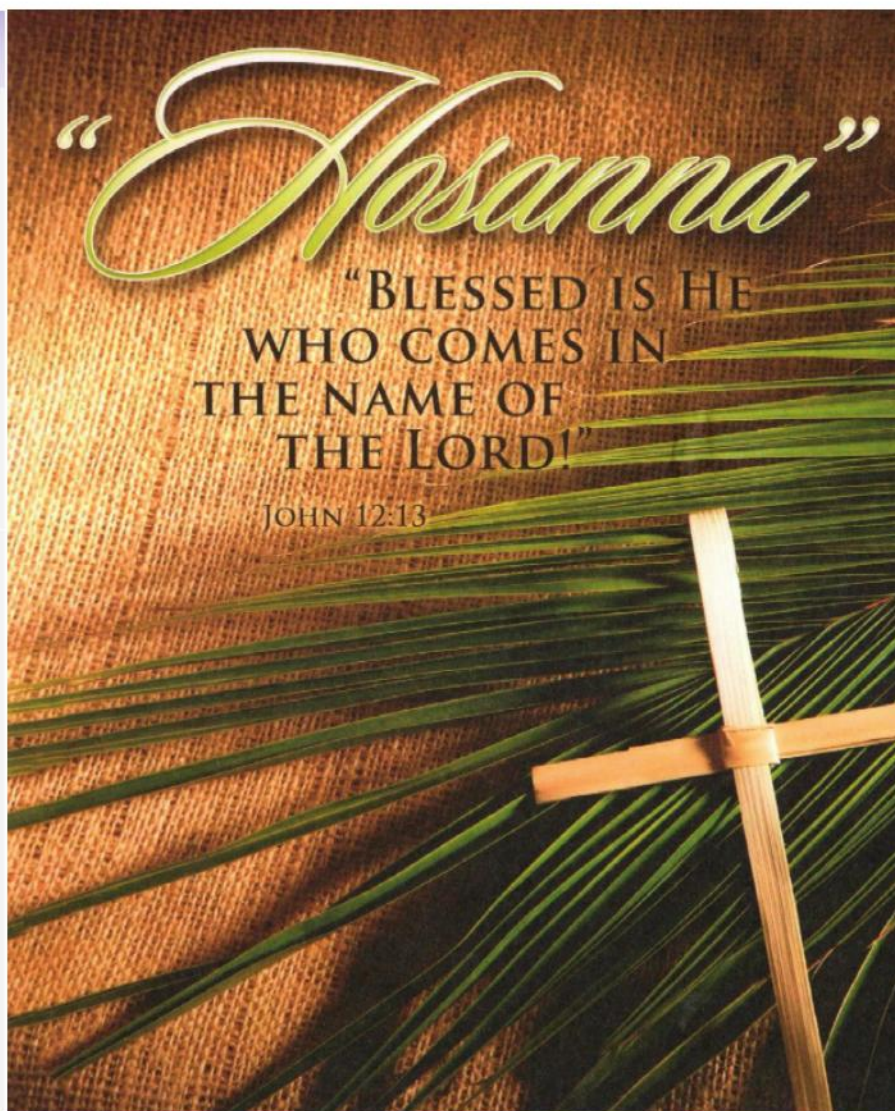

## From our Pastor

We have transitioned officially from the winter season to the spring season. Soon the trees will bud, and their leaves will burst forth. The daffodils and crocuses will push through the earth and share their splendor with us. The days are longer, and the warmth of the sun will comfort us. Like the seasons of the year, change is on-going. At times, we look forward to change and it is pleasant. However, change can also be difficult and challenging. Regardless, change is a reality and happens whether we like it or not. Everyday we awaken and place our feet on the floor, we have changed. We have grown another day older.

Just as seasons and we change on a regular basis, the world and the church are involved in change. Change is happening in the Erie Diocese that makes up the thirteen counties of northwest Pennsylvania. Let's look at how change has taken place in the Erie Diocese over the past thirty years.

### Mass attendance

1990 approximately 120,000 Catholics were attending Mass.  
2012 there were 52,000 attending.  
2019 there were almost 37,000 in attendance.  
2022 there were around 27,000 in attendance.

### Number of active priests serving the Erie Diocese

In 1990 there were 210 active priests.  
In 2012 there were 130 active priests.  
In 2022 there were 99 active priests.  
In 2023 there are 92 active priests.

### Number of Parishes in the Erie Diocese

In 1990 there were 127 parishes.  
In 2012 there were 117 parishes.  
In 2023 there are 93 parishes.

The diocese has experienced change even farther back than thirty years. In our area of the diocese, St. George Church in Soldier was closed in 1972; St. Anthony Church in Helvetia was closed in 1955; St. Helen Church in Eleanora was closed in 1933. More recently, St. Joseph Church in DuBois was closed in 2019.

The above data and historical references remind us that our ancestors experienced transition in their lives just as we do today. As the Greek philosopher, Socrates, stated centuries ago: "The secret to change is to focus all your energy, not on fighting the old, but on building the new." In the same vein, history frequently repeats itself. The time, place, and people may be different, but change is on-going in our lives, the world, business, medicine, and the church.

As we have entered Holy Week, on this Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, may we be guided by the Christ's suffering, death, and resurrection and strive to bring renewed vigor and vitality to the Erie Diocese and DuBois Area Roman Catholic Churches.

### **Child Abuse Prevention Month**

Reporting known or suspected child abuse: It is every adult's moral responsibility to report known or suspected abuse or neglect of a minor to the responsible authorities. Sexual responsible authorities. Sexual abuse of minors is a pervasive societal problem, and only concerted and sustained efforts by all adults in every segment of society can help to protect children and youth. In the 2021 Pennsylvania statewide report there were 5,036 substantiated reports of child abuse in Pennsylvania. 2,171 or 39.9% of the substantiated reports were for sexual abuse, 1,418 were physical abuse. Parents remain the persons most responsible for abuse of their children. To report suspected abuse of a minor, call Childline at 1-800-932-0323 (anytime 24/7).
