#### The Feast of St. Blaise

Saint Blaise was the bishop of Sebaste in Armenia during the fourth century. Very little is known about his life. According to various accounts, he was a physician before becoming a bishop. His cult spread throughout the entire Church in the Middle Ages because he was reputed to have miraculously cured a little boy who nearly died because of a fishbone in his throat. From the eighth century, he has been invoked on behalf of the sick, especially those afflicted with illnesses of the throat. The blessing of throats may be given by a priest, deacon, or lay minister. When the blessing is conferred during Mass, the blessing follows the homily and general intercessions.

Janus is the name of a Roman god. The god had two faces pointed in opposite directions. This god looked to the past with one face and toward the future with another. The god was also referred to as the "god of doors." The word "door" in Latin is ianua. One can see the root of our modern word "January." Switch the i to a j, which is often done from Latin to English, and we see "January." In other words, January is a month which opens the door to the new year.
