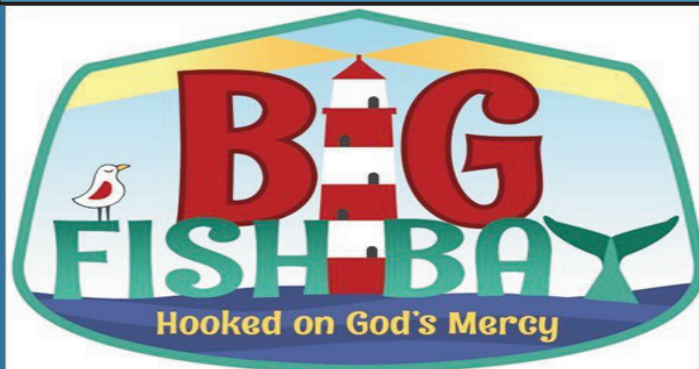

Deacon Ben's Corner



The deacon says at the end of Mass - "Go in peace" or "Go in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life" or "Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord." These dismissals are not simply a comfortable phrase to conclude the Mass. In fact, they are quite the opposite. "Go" is the great command that we see throughout the entire Biblical Narrative. It's not possible to find a moment in the Bible when God encounters a person and doesn't send them on mission. I often have to make sure that I am not just saying "Go in peace" at the end of the Mass but rather that I am also listening to those words and living them out. One of the greatest gifts that we can give others is being a friend in such a way that those around us can hear God's personal command to them - to go, to go be a saint, to go be fully alive, to go and grow in Holiness. Lastly, if you are looking for a one line phrase from God to live your life by - it wouldn't be a bad idea to consider "*Go in peace.*" It's courageous, bold, adventurous and on the path to Heaven. It strikes at the heart of the Catholic faith.




