### What is Eschatology? Last Things (part 2)

**Heaven.** Imagine the most perfect day. Some would say this is **Heaven**. Imagine being totally free from worries, being at your best in serving others with your gifts and talents. This is **Heaven** too.

Now, imagine a world where everyone is at peace with each other. No more wars, violence, and poverty. Everyone is completely healed of their ills, sickness, and inabilities. Everyone is happy and knows and loves God and each other. Most would say this is **Heaven**. Maybe all of the above is **Heaven**.

Hell. We have always been told that this is the place where nobody wants to end up when we die. Why? The Catechism of the Catholic Church says "that this is the state of definitive self-exclusion from communion with God and the blessed..." (CCC 1033) A person in Hell is cut off for all eternity from God's Love and Presence and the presence of others.

The most important thing we need to know is how to avoid Hell when we pass away from this life.

- 1. Live the Ten Commandments daily.
- 2. Live Jesus' Commandment of love the best you can.
- 3. Confess mortal and deadly sins when they are committed: pride, anger, envy, avarice, greed, lust, and sloth.
- 4. Grow in your knowledge of God's Will.
- 5. Meet the needs of the poor, ill, and the needy the best you are able.

**Purgatory.** "All who die in God's Grace and Friendship, but still imperfectly purified, are indeed assured of their eternal salvation; but after death they undergo purification, so as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of Heaven." (CCC 1030)

The Church gives the name **Purgatory** to this final purification of souls. Probably most souls are in **Purgatory** before their preparation of **Heaven**. Striving for holiness and living Jesus' sermon on the Mount (Mt: Chapters 5-7) may help avoid **Purgatory**.

Christ's Second Coming. The last judgment of Christ when He returns in glory is described in this Sunday's Gospel on this Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. In short, if we strive to serve Christ, Who lives in the least of our brothers and sisters, we will inherit the Kingdom of Heaven.

New Heaven, Earth, and Resurrection of the Body. This fullness of God's Promise is a new universe, the heavenly Jerusalem "where God will have His Dwelling among men." (Rev 21: 5) "God is preparing a new dwelling and a new earth in which righteousness dwells, in which happiness will fill and surpass all the desires of peace arising in the hearts of men." (Vat II document Gaudium et Spes 39)

#### **BULLETIN INFORMATION**

### SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

**Baptism** – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

**Eucharist** – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

**Confirmation** – High School youth who are entering the 9<sup>th</sup> grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

**R.C.I.A.** – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

#### SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

**Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate** – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

**Matrimony** – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

### SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick-Celebrated for all who are seriously ill. The Sacrament is also available upon request.

**Reconciliation** – Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
