Epiphany Welcome to the Eucharistic Table of Jesus Our Savior

A table is a very important piece of furniture in our homes. This is where we sit, eat, talk, and share ideas and stories. It is also a place where many choose to do business like writing or paying bills. Also, decisions are made there.

During Mass, the Eucharistic Table of Jesus our Savior refers to the Tables of God's Word (The Liturgy of the Word) and the Altar (The Liturgy of the Eucharist). As our tables are important to us in our homes, this Table is very important in the Church. At this Table we are invited to listen to ancient Biblical Stories that affirm our faith. We are invited to listen to the New Testament Readings and the Proclamation of one of the Gospel writers Matthew, Mark, Luke, or John. Then, the Prayer of Consecration is prayed over the gifts of bread and wine to become the Body and Blood of Christ. Following this, we are invited to receive Jesus our Savior in Holy Communion.

In the weeks ahead I will continue to share excerpts from Dr. Ed Sri's book, <u>A Biblical Walk</u>, of the Mass. The Mass is a vitally important celebration to our personal and family life. May all feel welcome as they enter the Church.

In our Gospel today, we celebrate the Epiphany. The Magi were welcomed by Mary and Joseph into their home to worship the Baby Jesus. May we, too, worship and adore Jesus our Savior during our prayer time and especially when we come together at Mass.

BULLETIN INFORMATION

Groups or individuals wishing to have information published in the bulletin are asked to submit the information in writing, by email or by phone by Monday at 10:00 a.m.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

SÁCRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick—Celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available upon request.

Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m, or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
