### **HOW OFTEN MUST I FORGIVE?**

I am familiar with a story of a group of guys who on a regular basis would go fishing and hunting throughout the year. One of the fellows was extremely good at both sports with a lot of experience and was more successful than the others. Two of the men from the group became angry and jealous at his luck and success so they broke away from the group. Eventually the other guys in their group did the same. The successful man felt hurt and betrayed by his friends.

Years later, this man and his family had moved to a different part of the state due to a new job opportunity. He met workers that enjoyed hunting and fishing, so he joined them. One of the fellows in his new group of friends was actually acquainted with one of the old friends from his past fishing and hunting group. When he found this out, he was apprehensive to continue his new acquaintance.

Eventually, his new friend convinced him to join him with his old friend at a dinner with other fishermen. The two men who had been estranged from each other got reacquainted and their friendship was healed and renewed.

## What happened? Forgiveness from the heart and with the help of friends.

In our Gospel Reading, Peter probably had some issues with one of the other Apostles, so he asked Jesus the question: "Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?" (Matthew 18: 21-22) Peter uses the number seven because that number indicates perfection in the Jewish way of thinking. Peter must have thought Jesus would immediately say 'yes' to that many times we must forgive. But what did Jesus say? "...I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times." (Matthew 18: 21-22) In other words, we must forgive others every time they sin against us.

OK, but this is tremendously difficult. True, but our Lord Who commands us to do this, will certainly give us the ability and the Grace to forgive. This Grace will be given in the Sacrament of Confession. Confess anger and unforgiveness in Confession and Jesus our Lord will give you the spiritual strength and grace to forgive others—even seventy-seven times, and possibly with the help of friends.

#### SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

**Baptism** – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

**Eucharist** – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the  $9^{th}$  grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

**R.C.I.A.** – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

### SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

**Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate** – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

**Matrimony** – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

### SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick-Celebrated for all who are seriously ill. The Sacrament is also available upon request.

**Reconciliation** – Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.


