September's Special Saints, Feasts and a Significant Day to Recall

September 3rd: Gregory the Great

Gregory was an interesting person who went from the job of prefect in Rome to Benedictine monk, to a priest to an abbot (head of a religious community) to becoming Pope. He was a reformer of the celebration of the Mass (Eucharist) and was responsible for giving the "Gregorian Chart" that is used during Mass.

September 8th: The Birthdate of Mary

This date was originally designated because the Church year of the Eastern Church begins with September which is nine months after December 8th, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. According to the Christian writing of the Protoevangelium of James, the parents of Mary are Anna and Joachim. They were not able to have children but they prayed for a child. Anna gave birth to Mary. This prayer being answered by God is the miracle that would eventually be instrumental to bring about an even greater miracle of God the Father's plan for salvation through Jesus our Lord.

September 11, 2001:

(A prayer from the courtesy of Father Matthew Ernest, Director of the Office of Worship of the Diocese of New York.)

This date 9-11, carries a heavy burden of memory. This day does not pass in the calendar without our Remembering. We remember images of death and destruction. Images that human eyes were never meant to see. We remember words our ears were never meant to hear, the tender last words of husbands and wives who would never embrace again.

We imagine the feeling of emptiness in the arms of children who at the end of the day could not find mom or dad for their welcome home hug. We remember our own feelings of emptiness as our sense of security, as our own confidence in the predictable order of life and work was radically shaken.

This date, 9-11, carries a heavy burden of memory. We remember the heroism of the many that lost their lives

in saving others. We remember all those who suffered and died; we grieve for them still, friends and strangers alike, along with their families and friends.

This date, 9-11, carries a heavy burden of memory.

And it is right that is should not pass from or memory.. But today, and in this prayer, along with our remembrance of profound loss, it also seems right that we give voice to our deep longing for peace, and with this prayer, commit ourselves to those actions that will draw us closer to our most ancient and most holy desire, peace among all God's children.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. - Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate - Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick-Celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available upon request. Reconciliation - The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 - 5:15 p.m, or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
