The Voice of the Good Shepherd

Our voice and the words we use as we speak are extremely important. How we use our voice can bring a wide range of emotions. If we speak softly using tender words of encouragement and affirmation to others, they will feel uplifted, welcomed and confident. Anyone who hears words of guidance, direction or even commands most likely will draw their full attention to the one speaking to them.

At a very young age we learn to recognize the voice of our parents as well as other members of the family. However, it is the one taking care of our needs, making commands and taking their precious time teaching us about ourselves and the little world around us who has the most effect in our lives.

In our Gospel Reading this weekend as we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday, Jesus says, "I am the Good Shepherd and I know mine and mine know me." (John 10:14) In addition, Jesus says, "I have other sheep that do not belong to this fold. These also I must lead, and they will hear My Voice…" (John 10:16)

The Voice of the Good Shepherd inspires us to trust in and follow Him. May each of us hear Jesus our Good Shepherd speaking to our hearts words of guidance, acceptance and truth and be willing to be that voice for others. **Pray for all who shepherd us.**

Easter Meditation

The Lord's Resurrection should bring to every day of life an Easter Spirit.

"At this time of the year the Gospels always lead us to think of the resurrection of Christ and also of our own. God invites us to consider what will happen in the future: our resurrection, paradise! Every day is Easter! May we renew ourselves every morning! The secret of the day lies in our morning exercises of piety. If we begin our day well, we can hope to continue and end it well.

"In the morning we should turn to God at once. When the morning practices are carelessly done, the day's duties will be still more carelessly carried out. In addition, we have Mass and Communion to enable us to live a new life in Christ: Christ lives in me. The object is to live a 'risen' life. Yesterday I was one kind of person, now I am another. This is what the resurrection of Christ means."

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick-Celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available upon request. Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m, or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
