We are More Than Conquerors

It's very helpful to occasionally look very closely to the words and their meaning of the Second Reading proclaimed at Mass. Most every Sunday throughout the liturgical church year, this Reading comes from one of St. Paul's letters. In this weekend's Reading, St. Paul is offering words of comfort and confident assurance in his letter to the Romans...

Romans 8:35, 37-39

Brothers and sisters:

What will separate us from the Love of Christ? Will anguish, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or the sword?

No, in all these things we conquer overwhelmingly through Him Who loved us.

For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor present things, nor future things, nor powers, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature will be able to separate us from the Love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord.

St. Paul himself is very familiar with trials and suffering in his life such as misunderstandings, shipwrecks, and a strange illness he called a "thorn in the flesh." (2 Cor 12:7) So, he speaks with the experience of understanding and compassion to his audience who are experiencing anguish, persecution, or the fierce weapon of the sword. These are physical and emotional issues and fears.

The remedy he tells us is the Love of Christ. We can even conquer overwhelmingly these malaise and humiliating experiences. He further says that anything in life and death itself and the unseen powers in the cosmos now and in the future will never separate us from Jesus' healing ever-present love for each of us.

My friends, what are the issues in your life that cause you either <u>right now</u> or at times to feel separated from God's love? Is it sin? If so, Jesus invites you to go to Confession. Is it the fear of this terrible Coronavirus? Pray, and do all you can to protect yourself. Is it not being able to go to Mass because of health problems, the virus threat, or anger towards God? Invite Jesus to take the problem and cling to the advice of St. Teresa of Avila who said, "Let nothing disturb you or frighten you, all things are passing. God never changes. Patience obtains all things and nothing is wanting to those who possess God. God alone suffices." Pray for the grace of these words.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick – Is celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available anytime upon request.

Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m, or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

PARISHIONER INFORMATION

All practicing Catholics living in the Bennetts Valley Area who consider themselves members of St. Joseph Parish should be registered in the parish. All registered members of St. Joseph receive envelopes and receive periodic parish mailings. St. Joseph Parish is a Sacrificial Giving Parish, committed to serving the Lord with God-given time, talents and treasures. All registered members should be using their envelopes regularly. Parish membership is required to be a sponsor, to be married in the parish, to have a child baptized or to be registered in our Faith Formation program. Please call the church office to arrange a meeting to register in our parish.
