## Lenten and Life Spiritual Exercise The Ten Commandments

How well are we all living the Ten Commandments? Take this time to reflect and correct every area of life that is not living out these commandments in the way God intended. (Exodus 20:1-17)

- 1. "I, the Lord, am you God. You shall not have other gods besides Me." Do we spend too much time caring or worrying about the things in our life that control our life, or too much pleasure in selfish pursuits? Do we strive to put God first in our lies instead of things?
- 2. "You shall not take the Name of the Lord your God in vain." Do we swear in taking God's Name? Or, are we exercising self-control in the midst of anger?
- 3. "Remember to keep Holy the Sabbath Day?" For us Catholics Christians, we all know that Sunday is the special day of the Lord we keep holy. Even though Sunday Mass is not obligatory at this time because of the pandemic, are we spending some good time in prayer like the Rosary, reading Sacred Scripture, having family prayer intentions or the Spiritual Communion Prayer?
- 4. "Honor your father and your mother." Are children obeying and respecting parents? Are younger adults respecting and taking their parents advice and guidance? Are all adults taking special care and concern of their elderly parents? Are all of us at any age respecting the elderly people in society, nursing homes, etc...?
- 5. "You shall not kill." This commandment not only forbids anyone to outright take another person's life but also forbids everyone in planning or assisting anyone else in ending another person's life. None of us has physically killed anyone we will say, but have we killed someone's spirit by discouraging them unfairly, bullying them or hurting someone in any way?

This Season of Lent is a perfect time to review these Ten Commandments of which I will complete next weekend.

### SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist - Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11<sup>th</sup> grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

#### SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate - Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

#### SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick-Celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available upon request. Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m, or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
