Lessons of Sacred Scripture (from an Easter Hymn)

Happy Easter! Today I share with you the lessons of Sacred Scripture that we can find in the following Easter hymn sung at Mass during the Easter season. The title is "Alleluia! Sing to Jesus!" The translation of this hymn comes from the prayer book of the Liturgy of the Hours, Catholic Book Pub. Co. NY 1976

"Alleluia! Sing to Jesus!"

Alleluia! Sing to Jesus! His the scepter His the throne; Alleluia! His the triumph, His the victory alone. Hark the songs of peaceful Sion, Thunder like a mighty flood; Jesus out of ev'ry nation, has redeemed us by His Blood.

Scripture Meaning: The beautiful words open with the title: "Alleluia! Sing to Jesus!" Absolutely, we are going to sing because His the scepter and throne mean He is eternal Heavenly King Who won the victory over death by His Blood. Peaceful Sion can be read in the Book of Isaiah 65:17-25. In verse 18 God says: "There shall always be rejoicing and happiness in what I create."

Alleluia! Not as orphans are we left in sorrow now. Alleluia! He is near us, faith believes nor questions how. Though the cloud from sight received Him, when the forty days were o'er, shall our hearts forget His promises "I am with you evermore."

Scripture Meaning: *Not as orphans are we left in sorrow now* refers to Jesus's words in the Gospel of John 14:18 where Jesus says: "I will not leave you orphaned I will come back to you." Jesus came back to us in His Resurrection. The gift of faith enables us to believe in these promises from Jesus. The meaning of the words *The cloud from sight receive Him when the forty days were o'er* refers to Jesus's Ascension into Heaven after being with His Apostles for forty days after His Resurrection. The last words of this verse are the encouraging words Jesus gives to His Apostles and to us in the Gospel of Matthew 28:20, "I am with you always." If we strive to love Jesus, He and the Heavenly Father in the Holy Spirit 'will come to us and make their dwelling place with us." (John 14:23)

Alleluia! Bread of angels, thou on earth our food, our stay. Alleluia here the sinful flee to thee from day to day. Intercessor, Friend of sinners, earth's Redeemer plead for me. Where the songs of all the sinless, sweep across the crystal sea.

Scripture Meaning: *Bread of Angels,...*line refers to Jesus, the Bread of Life (John 6) *Intercessor Friend of sinners*—connected to Hebrews 7:5. *Crystal sea* can be found in the Book of Revelations 22:1. This is a beautiful image of Heaven. God Bless.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick—Celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available upon request. Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m, or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
