What is Eschatology? (part 1)

The word Eschatology is the study of the *last things* pertaining to our life here on earth and our relationship with God. The *last things* are death, judgment, Heaven and Hell. Further extension of these *last things* is the reality of Purgatory, Christ – the Second Coming and the Resurrection of the body and life everlasting. Much has been written and said about these *last things* and the reality of them. In brief, let us look at each one.

- that every human being will go through some day. It is the separation of our soul from the body. For us as people of faith in God the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, we believe that our eternal soul will stand before our eternal God upon our death. We further believe that Jesus our Lord and Savior lived and died for us to save us from our sins and from being eternally separated from God upon our human death. Our hope for eternal life rests in the fact that we have lived out our baptismal calling in loving God, neighbor and self the best we can here on earth and to know our Lord through prayer. Doing this now prepares us for the next reality after we die judgment.
- **† Judgment.** There are two types of judgment: a particular judgment and a general judgment (last judgment). The particular judgment is when upon each person's death, they will immediately appear before God. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says that "each man receives his eternal retribution in his immortal soul at the very moment of his death, in a particular judgment that refers his life to Christ: either entrance into the blessedness of Heaven through a purification or immediately, or immediate and everlasting damnation." (CCC 1022) St. John of the Cross offers us some loving words of advice in preparing for this judgment in his writing called *Dichos* 64. He says, "At the evening of life, we shall be judged on our love." That's it. Living Jesus's Command of love will enable us to get to Heaven. All of us followers of Christ hope that Jesus's words to us when we appear before Him would be the words He spoke to the people who multiplied the talents of their master in today's Gospel: "Well done, my good and faithful servant." (Mt 25:23a)

The *general judgment* also called the *last judgment* happens at the end of the world when Jesus returns to judge the living and the dead. This *last judgment* will be explained further next weekend when we hear about Christ's Second Coming at Mass in which we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick – Is celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available anytime upon request.

Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m, or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
