The Power of Resurrection and the Power of Our Baptism

These next eight weeks, during this glorious Season of Easter, we will celebrate, Christ's Resurrection from the dead. The Power of Christ's Resurrection has broken the chains of death and has given us all the invitation to a new life in our Lord Jesus Christ. This new life begins with our Baptism.

The power of the Sacrament of Baptism of which we have all received enables us to live in the Power of Christ's Resurrection. In Saint Paul's *Letter to the Colosians* he says, "And you were buried with Him in Baptism, in which you were also raised with Him through faith in the working of God, Who raised Him from the dead ... If then, you have been raised with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is seated at the right Hand of God." (Colosians 2:12—3:1)

Indeed, the power of our Baptism enables us to want to seek the things of God such as love, joy, and peace with God and neighbor. But, the Power of Baptism also has a new life of a Divine Healing quality.

A unique story of Divine Healing goes as follows... After a Saturday evening Mass, a visiting priest was asked to go to the hospital immediately in order to baptize a baby who was just born but would stop breathing. The baby would actually breathe and pause for some moments and then struggle to take the next breath. The priest baptized the little one and anointed her with the *Oil of Chrism*. A half-hour later, when the priest returned to the rectory, he received a phone call from the hospital and was told that the baby is now breathing regularly on her own. The next day he was told that she is still breathing on her own. This event to us, my friends, is the Power of Jesus's Resurrection released in the waters of Baptism to create the power of Divine Healing.

My brothers and sisters of St. Joseph Parish family, I pray that all of us experience the Grace and Power of Jesus's Resurrection in our own unique way during this Easter Season. May the special prayers and miracles we prayed for during Lent and the sacrifices of time spent serving and hearts-spent giving, bring a transformation and continued healing in our life. SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist - Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick-Celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available upon

Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m., or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
