Where is Your True Treasure?

In our Gospel Reading, as we just heard, Jesus refuses to take sides of a sibling complaining about the brother. Two weeks ago, it was Martha asking Jesus to tell her sister, Mary, to help her. Now, in this Reading the person in the crowd asks Jesus to tell his brother to share the inheritance. He figures Jesus will be on his side. "It is only fair to share, right, Jesus?" the man asks. Jesus takes this opportunity to refocus this person on what matters to God and about growing rich in the sight of God. Jesus begins by saying, "take care to guard against all greed."

Greed is an excessive desire for wealth and/or possessions. Jesus then gives an illustration in the parable about a rich farmer.

Now, this wealthy farmer was not portrayed by Jesus as a sinful person. He did not steal or cheat his laborers. It was a good growing season that made him rich. He was an honest, hard-working, smart business man. Probably, he had prepared for many years of leisure and prosperity for himself and not for someone else. He never got the opportunity to use it because that "night his life would be demanded (by God) of him." (Luke 12:21) He grew rich in material things, but not rich in the most important thing — a relationship with God — taking that love and sharing with others.

For us, I believe, in many ways I'm preaching to the choir. I'm preaching to you. **You** have a relationship with God. This relationship with God is what is most important in your life or you would not be here.

I thank you for coming to Mass week after week and spending your time by worshiping together with our Eucharistic Lord.

BULLETIN INFORMATION

Groups or individuals wishing to have information published in the bulletin are asked to submit the information in writing, by email or by phone by Monday at 10:00 a.m.

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

SÁCRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick-Celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available upon request.

Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m, or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
