

The School of Lent

Are you enrolled in the school of Lent? The "school" begins on Ash Wednesday and concludes at the beginning of the Holy Triduum; the Mass of the Lord's Supper-Holy Thursday.

Of course, we call it the Holy Season of Lent. But, in many ways, this Holy Season is like a "school" where we spend more time than ever learning about God and the Sacraments of the Church, especially the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and the Holy Eucharist.

This Holy Season and "school" of Lent is especially a necessary opportunity to learn about ourselves, our relationship with Jesus our Lord, and areas of our lives that we need to work on in order to become the <u>holy person</u> God is calling each of us to be and to become even more.

We first want to consider what Jesus tells us in our short Gospel reading from Mark this weekend when He says; "This is the time of fulfillment. The Kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and believe in the Gospel." (MK 1: 15) So, let's look at each one of these sentences and see for ourselves what Jesus is saying to each of us individually.

"This is the time of fulfillment." Ask yourself; what longing, what need, what healing or blessing that has started in your life that has not been fulfilled? Ask Jesus to bring it to a greater fulfillment. Read a scripture passage, such as in St. Paul's letter to the Philippians Ch 1 Verse 6 that says; "I am sure of this much: that God Who has begun a good work in you will carry it through to completion right up to the day of Christ Jesus." Claim these words in prayer for the area of your life that needs fulfillment.

"The Kingdom of God is at hand." The kingdom in Jesus' Mind is all of the good things that He wants us to have for our human life here on earth that will prepare us for the absolutely glorious, fulfilling, ever-lasting life of Heaven. St. Paul calls it "justice, peace, and the joy that is given by the Holy Spirit." (Romans Ch. 14: 17) If all of these virtues and many other good, spiritual benefits were at hand (or close by) during Jesus' time, how much more at hand are they to us today? Pray for them and thank God for them. What great gifts and virtues these are in our lives and in the lives of the people around us.

"Repent and believe in the Gospel." Ah, here is where the "school" of Lent really needs to take place. First, what are the areas we need repent of and go to confession in order to receive the healing forgiveness of Jesus our Lord?

Finally, believing in the Gospel means to believe in the Good News of Christ. What this means to each of us personally is to take time in this "school" of Lent to read the Gospel daily and pray for the Grace to <u>BELIEVE</u> that the Life, Words, and Actions of Christ our Lord will help to transform areas of your life and make you more of a disciple of Christ in the "school" of <u>LIFE</u> as well as in the "school" of LENT. Groups or individuals wishing to have information published in the bulletin are asked to submit the information in writing, by email or by phone by **Monday** at **10:00 a.m**.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 9th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick-Celebrated for all who are seriously ill. The Sacrament is also available upon request.

Reconciliation – Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
