

Parts of the Mass The Penitential Act and the Gloria

The Penitential Act

Number 51 on page 55 of the Roman Missal states "... the Priest calls upon the whole community to take part in the Penitential Act, which after a brief pause for silence, it does by means of a formula of general confession."

An example of this is . . .

The Priest: Lord Jesus, You have shown us the way

to the Father. . . . Lord, have mercy.

The people: *Lord, have mercy.*

The Priest: Lord Jesus, You have given us the

consolation of the truth

Christ, have mercy.

The people: *Christ, have mercy.*

The Priest: Lord Jesus, You are the Good Shepherd

leading us into everlasting life . . .

The people: Lord, have mercy.

The Priest: May Almighty God have mercy on us,

forgive us our sins and bring us to everlasting life. (Penitential Act VI. page 1479)

Another option of the Penitential Act is done throughout the Liturgical year and especially during the Season of Lent. This option is **The Confiteor**.

The Priest and the People:

The Confiteor

I confess to Almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; therefore I ask Blessed Mary ever-Virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God.

The Priest: May Almighty God have mercy on us,

forgive us our sins, and bring us to ever

lasting life.

The people: Amen.

The Gloria

The Gloria is truly a hymn of praise built into the Mass. The Roman Missal states "the Gloria to God in the Highest is a most ancient and venerable hymn by which the Church gathered in the Holy Spirit, glorifies and entreats God the Father and the Lamb. (RM pg. 31) (The Gloria will be printed in full in the next bulletin)

BULLETIN INFORMATION

Groups or individuals wishing to have information published in the bulletin are asked to submit the information in writing, by email or by phone by Monday at 10:00 a.m.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick-Celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available upon request.

Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m, or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
