## The Image of Divine Mercy

In 1931, our Lord Jesus Christ appeared to St. Faustina in a vision. St. Faustina was from Poland where she had received the visions. She saw Jesus clothed in a white garment with His right hand raised in a way as He was giving a blessing. His left hand was touching His garment in the area of His heart where two large rays of light came forth. One of the rays of light was red and the other pale in color.

In the vision our Lord explained to St. Faustina the meaning of His Mercy flowing from the rays. They represent Blood and Water. The pale ray stands for water which makes the soul righteous. The red ray stands for the Blood which is life for the soul. The image of our Divine Merciful Lord indicates and represents all of the graces of Divine Mercy which is being poured out upon the world and especially within the Holy Sacraments of Baptism and the Eucharist.

The feast day was established by St. Pope John Paul II when he made the announcement during his homily at the canonization of St Faustina on April 30, 2000. It was there that he declared: "It is important then that we accept the whole message that comes to us from the Word of God on the Second Sunday of Easter, which from now on throughout the Church, will be called 'Divine Mercy Sunday.""

### **Are You Like Thomas?**

On this special day when we celebrate Divine Mercy, in our Gospel Reading we hear the healing Words of Jesus when He appears to His Apostles: "Peace be with you." He continues to offer healing to them by the Holy Spirit Who can bring them Forgiveness. Forgiveness towards each other and towards the Pharisees and Roman soldiers who condemned Jesus to death. We also hear of Thomas who had the problem of doubt. Jesus continues His Healing by showing Thomas that He is truly present with His Words: "Put your finger here in my hand and side and believe." Thomas was healed of his doubt.

My friends, a good question for all of us . . . Where in our lives do we need Jesus's Healing PEACE, His Healing FORGIVENES, and His Healing FROM DOUBT.

#### SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

**Baptism** – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist - Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

#### SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

### SÁCRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick-Celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available upon

Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m., or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
