
Fourth Sunday of Advent God's Promise to St. Joseph and to Us

During this Fourth Sunday of Advent, we begin to hear of the events surrounding Jesus's Birth. In our Gospel the remarkable story of Joseph, a righteous man who listened to the Angel in a dream, found a way to make room in his life and in his heart for this unexpected child.

Joseph's faith had a developing process in that he begins to understand that he is <u>uniquely</u> the recipient and guardian of God's long-awaited promise—the Messiah Jesus. He is given consolation and peace in the knowledge of Sacred Scripture being fulfilled as we heard from Isaiah in our First Reading today "the Virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and shall name Him Emmanuel. (Is 7:14)
God is with us (Mt 1:24). Joseph obeys God's commands, takes Mary as his wife into his home, and becomes the human father of the Son of God.

My brothers and sisters, we, too, are recipients of God's Promise of Christ Jesus our Lord and Savior. Through our Baptism, the Sacraments, and our personal prayer time with God, we receive graces and blessings especially in the Mass. In the Holy Eucharist we receive God's Word and Jesus Himself as we go to the Altar and receive the Body and Blood, Soul, and Divinity of Christ our Lord. Pray that Jesus's Gift to us in the Mass is always shining with great anticipation and desire in our lives and brings about fulfilling happiness.

BULLETIN INFORMATION

Groups or individuals wishing to have information published in the bulletin are asked to submit the information in writing, by email or by phone by Monday at 10:00 a.m.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

SÁCRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick-Celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available upon request.

Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m, or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
