Why We Receive Ashes and The Creed

We receive ashes on Ash Wednesday with the Sign of the Cross on our forehead to remind us that we are dust from the earth; that we will pass from this life someday and our bodies will return to the earth. Hopefully, our soul will live on throughout eternity with God. It is also a reminder that we are to let go and rid ourselves of the sins and distractions that get in the way of our relationship with God. We do this by repenting of our sins and asking God for forgiveness. This especially happens in the Sacrament of Confession. Lent is the season of opportunity for personal and spiritual renewal by means of acts of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving.

The Creed at Mass

Continuing with the next part of **The Creed**, we are reminded of the brief history lesson of the purpose of Jesus our Savior's Coming into the world for our salvation. First, He was incarnate of the Virgin Mary and became man. The Catechism of the Catholic Church says that "Incarnate means that the Son of God assumed a human nature in order to accomplish our salvation in it." (CCC461) **The Creed** goes on to proclaim what Jesus did for us in His adult life for our sake — He was crucified under Pontius Pilate, He suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into Heaven and is seated at the right Hand of the Father.

That is what Jesus did for us. The next part of The Creed proclaims what Jesus will do in the future that He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and His Kingdom will have no end. Next, we proclaim our belief in the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity—The Holy Spirit. In short, the Holy Spirit is the Giver of life who proceeds from the Father and the Son and Who is adored and glorified and spoken through the prophets.

Finally, we express our belief in One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church (which are also called the *Four Marks* of the Church). We then confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins, and we look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. We end with *Amen* which means — so be it — and yes, certainly. This is what we believe as Catholics.

Always believe in The Father, The Son and The Holy Spirit to help in life's challenges and always believe that the Joy of the Lord will be your strength. Never Stop Believing.

SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

Baptism – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

Eucharist – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

Confirmation – High School youth who are entering the 11th grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

R.C.I.A. – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

Matrimony – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick—Celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available upon request.

Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m., or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated
