to the Eucharistic Table of Jesus our Savior here at St. Joseph Church as We Worship Together in the 2020's.

Some of the most joyful and memorable activities in our life are the times when we did things together as a family. Some delightful memories were the times we vacationed together and had gone to special celebrations with relatives. These occasional events happened yearly — and, everyone looked forward to them.

Normally, the participation whether at a dinner or on vacation was conversing and sharing thoughts with each other. Today, families will use social media to also include others who could not be with them at these events. Of course, one of these family experiences that involve active participation is going to Mass on the weekend and worshipping together as a parish family.

Often, the term *active participation* at Mass has been interpreted as people being more involved in the ministries of the Church (and, where we **need** more individuals to be involved). On a deeper level, however, Pope Emeritis Benedict XVI states in his book The Spirit of the Liturgy (p.173) "The real action in the Liturgy in which we are all supposed to participate is the action of God Himself." The real action of God is the words of the Eucharistic Prayer of which we are attentive to and which necessitates the responses of the people in the pews and the priest praying the Eucharistic Prayer. Example of this is "The Lord be with you and with your Spirit."

Next week, I will conclude with this reflection of *Welcome to Mass*.

#### SACRAMENTS OF INITIATION

**Baptism** – A baptism preparation session is required of all parents wishing to have their child(ren) baptized. Parents must be registered parishioners. Sessions are held periodically at parishes throughout the Deanery. It is always preferred that baptisms be celebrated during a regular Sunday Liturgy. Call the Parish office for more information.

**Eucharist** – Children preparing for Eucharist (Gr. 3) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.

**Confirmation** – High School youth who are entering the 11<sup>th</sup> grade and who are active in the Faith Formation process or attend a Catholic High School since 9th grade are eligible to enter the Confirmation preparation sessions.

**R.C.I.A.** – Rite of Christian Initiation for adults are initiated into the Church through this process. Any individual who may be interested in becoming a member of the Catholic Church is invited. Please call the Church office.

#### SACRAMENTS OF VOCATION

**Priesthood/Permanent Deaconate** – Men who feel that they may be being called to the vocational life of Priesthood or Deaconate can contact the pastor at any time or call the Diocesan Vocation Office at 814-824-1111.

**Matrimony** – There is a required preparation process which normally includes 3 sessions with the pastor and an Engagement Encounter or Nova experience. Please notify the pastor at least 6 months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

#### SACRAMENTS OF HEALING

Sacrament of Anointing of the Sick – Is celebrated for all who are seriously ill annually at a parish Liturgy. The Sacrament is also available anytime upon request.

Reconciliation – The sacrament is celebrated weekly on Saturday from 4:45 – 5:15 p.m, or anytime by request. Parish Penance services are celebrated during Advent and Lent. Children preparing for Reconciliation (Gr. 2) and who are active in the Faith Formation process (including Catholic School children) are eligible to enter the sacramental preparation sessions.
