If you would like a printed copy, you may request one from the Parish Office. This report from the Erie Diocese will be integrated into the report of the Dioceses of Pennsylvania and New Jersey. You may also obtain from the office a summary report of our listening sessions here at St. Joseph. Listening sessions were held at St, Joseph beginning February 20<sup>th</sup>. A total of 40 people participated and there were six different listening session groups. Most groups met for three listening sessions. Two follow-up sessions were held as well, and a report with recommendations was presented to the Pastoral Council in June for their review.
