# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Last week in my column I mentioned that the pyramid model of the church has a tendency to undervalue the dignity of each baptized person because of the top-down emphasis. Each baptized person shares in the role of Priest, Prophet and King. During the Rite of Baptism, the priest or deacon anoints the crown of the head of the infant saying the words "he now anoints you with the chrism of salvation. As Christ was anointed Priest, Prophet, and King, so may you live always as a member of his body, sharing everlasting life." These words indicate the dignity of the baptized who now share in the roles that the Lord himself lived out in his life.

The sharing in these roles indicate the importance of every baptized person in God's plan of salvation. In other words, the life of each baptized person is a grace-filled moment of encounter in which Christ working through the baptized person brings salvation to the world.

At the end of each Mass, a person is sent into the world specifically for this grace-filled moment of encounter. The baptized person comes to Mass to experience the presence of Jesus Christ in word and sacrament, in the priest and the community, to be nourished and strengthened to carry out this mission.

All the baptized share in this wonderful privilege and responsibility. Father Ríck
