FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

This past Tuesday we held the ceremony celebrating the *Peace Pole*. Clearly the most popular part of the ceremony was the release of the doves. Throughout the ceremony there were explanations of what we were doing, why release doves, as well as two songs and accompanying gestures. In a very short homily, I told the students that while on retreat, I walked past a sign that linked non-violence and peace. While the Gospel reading told us that the gift of Jesus is peace, the road of acceptance of that gift is non-violence.

Over the past 100 years there are a number of examples of men and women committed to non-violence. Perhaps the two most famous examples are Mahatma Gandhi and Martin Luther King. Each man responded to the violence they received in non-violent ways. In each case these two men effected great changes as well as leaving us a legacy of the right pathway to peace.

Jesus, throughout the Gospels, demonstrates consistently a non-violent approach to life. If someone slaps you on the one cheek, offer him the other. The most striking example of non-violent reaction in the Gospels is, of course, the crucifixion. Jesus never protested his innocence, never condemned those who had him executed, but rather said "Father, forgive them. They know not what they do."

Pope Saint Paul VI once said, "if you want peace, work for justice". Just make sure that the justice work you do is non-violent.
