VOLUNTEERS TO SERVE AS USHERS

Even with the uncertainties of COVID, we are continuing to plan for our Christmas Masses. We have no idea what to expect for attendance but want to be prepared. We anticipate the 4:30 Christmas Eve Mass to be the most attended even though there is no children’s choir or pageant. CHRISTMAS FOOD BASKETS

Once again, beginning Thanksgiving Day through December 17th, St. Joseph Parish will help the Salvation Army by collecting items for 80 of our county’s neediest families for Christmas. Due to Covid-19, however, we need to alter the process and game plan regarding the packing and distribution of boxes. We are not accepting donations of food items and we are limiting the number of volunteers needed to pack and distribute the boxes. Recipients are being asked to pick up their boxes at Holy Redeemer Church.

Please do not donate turkeys or food items

We would appreciate donations of paper products such as kleenex, paper towels, toilet paper and napkins. These items can be left on the altar steps. **Gift cards** from Aldi, Shurfine, Tops or Walmart will be given to the families to supplement their food boxes. Monetary donations are useful to purchase turkeys, fresh foods locally and from Erie’s Second Harvest Food Bank. Please designate on the envelope or check that the money is for **Christmas Food Baskets**. Make checks payable to St Joseph Church and place your envelopes and gift cards in the collection baskets or leave in the parish office or mail to the church address.
