

**Blessed Carlo Acutis,
Patron of the Eucharistic Revival**

Blessed Carlo Acutis was an Italian teenager who had a tremendous love for Jesus in the Eucharist. He always attended Daily Mass and he studied Eucharistic miracles which have occurred around the world. He developed leukemia and offered his suffering to the Lord for the Church and the Holy Father. He died in 2006 at the age of 15 and was beatified by Pope Francis in 2020. A relic of Blessed Carlo will be coming to the Erie Diocese in May 2023.

Here are the words of Blessed Carlo: “ **How can we be sad if we always have God beside us? Basically, we’re more fortunate than the disciples of Jesus’ own time, for we can always encounter Jesus personally . We only have to go into the nearest church.**”

Eucharistic Sunday is October 16th: All the parishes of the diocese are celebrating Eucharistic Sunday with special prayers for Eucharistic Revival. The USCCB is launching a three year Eucharistic revival in hopes of increasing devotion and belief in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. Here in Warren, the Catholic Community will come together on October 16 to pray for such a revival. Holy Redeemer Church will host **35 hours of Adoration** and silent prayer. This is a wonderful opportunity for individuals and families to pray together. In fact, children are encouraged to come! **Please consider signing up for a 30 or 60 minute time slot.
