Reminder: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are also days of **fasting**. On these days, those bound by the law of fasting (18yrs.-58 yrs.) may take one full meal. Two smaller meals are also permitted. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids including milk and fruit juices are allowed. When health or work is seriously affected, the law does not oblige.

Reminder: Ash Wednesday, Fridays in Lent and Good Friday are days of **abstinence from eating meat** for those 14 years of age and older. March 19th the Solemnity of St Joseph falls on a Friday in Lent this year. The abstinence from meat is not mandatory on that Friday.
