Youth Ministry Summer Update



Every year the St. Jude youth group participates in a mission trip to the Finger Lakes region of New York and helps out poor farmers and their families in this rural area. I have been taking kids there for 11 years and finally this year, we were witness to a beautiful wedding between one of my former youth and one of their youth after meeting many years ago. This mission trip has been a cornerstone for our program here at St. Jude and has ignited a fire for service-based activities where the youth are able to reach out and touch faith.

While doing a retreat near Pittsburgh this fall, I heard about a powerful mission experience happening in Youngstown, Ohio. I arranged a meeting with Fr. Edward Brienz from the Youngstown Diocese and I wanted to learn more about his mission. After a fantastic meeting with him at the diocese I decided to

go scope out the landscape of Youngstown before fully committing to this two-week experience. This is where my heart was moved...

Fr. Ed runs homes for young adults who are in need guidance and vision in their life. Many of these young people have been given up on by their families and friends. While staying in these group homes they have to work at his Augustine Café in Youngstown, Ohio. Here they learn proper work techniques and the discipline to earn their daily wage and contribute to their local society.

Fr. Ed had no idea that I was coming to the Augustine Café that day and the experience was truly moving. As I walked into the café, I was taken back by the sincere love that these young adults showed towards any visitors. Fr. Ed saw that I had come down and he invited me over to his table. One young person after the next who walked through that door saw Fr. Ed and came over to greet him with arms wide open. You could see just how many people this man had helped throughout his years of service. Our server's name was Mac, when Mac had taken our order, Fr. Ed told me his story. Mac was brought to the café months ago, his mother brought him into the café and introduced him to Fr. Ed. She said, "this is my son Mac, he is 19 years old and I don't get a check for him anymore, he is your problem now!" After saying that she left her son there in the café with only the clothes on his back. I want to report that Mac is doing well. He has a family now, through the Church.



I am proud to say that we are taking 30 people this June to Youngstown and they will be served their meals at the Augustine Café. Youth from our school, youth group, and religious education program will be painting houses, cleaning diocese properties, and doing yard work throughout the city helping to restore hope to a struggling neighborhood. When people attack the Church, just remember Fr. Ed and Mac! Pray for us this summer as we continue the 12th year of mission in New York and start new memories in Ohio. Remember that the Church is ALIVE!

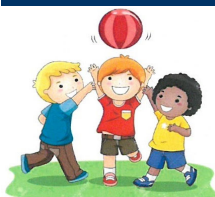


