From the desk of the Pastor

Today is the great Feast of the Most Holy Trinity, celebrating the mystery of our God as Father, Son, & Spirit: God, the Father, who created us and breathed life into us ... God, the Son, who redeemed us by His suffering, death, and Resurrection for the forgiveness of our sins ... God, the Holy Spirit, who is a constant source of strength, guidance, and protection. On this great Feast, we ponder this sacred union of the Holy Trinity, always reaching out to us, drawing us into an intimate relationship by creating us, redeeming us, and making us holy. May we all pray that we will respond to this invitation by inviting so many others in our lives into a loving relationship with our God as Father, Son, and Spirit ... especially, our children and our young people.

Even with this Feast of the Holy Trinity, we have resumed the season of "Ordinary Time", now beginning the 11th Week. Ordinary Time will now run all the way until the First Sunday of Advent on December 1st. This season does not really have any distinctive character, as would the seasons of Advent, Christmas, Lent, or Easter. There really isn't any specific mystery of Christ that we celebrate. But, rather, these 34 weeks of Ordinary Time are devoted to all the mysteries of Christ in their fullness. We will be focusing on so many of the teachings of Jesus, as He challenges us in our discipleship. The Sunday readings are to be the focus of the week, and I try to prepare a homily that allows us to think about and be challenged throughout that week, too. May we remember, "Sunday" is to the "week" what "Easter" is to the "year". May we allow the sacredness of Sunday challenge us to keep the rest of the week holy. And, may we allow all the teachings of Ordinary Time to be great challenges for us to be better disciples; and, ultimately, better people, fully prepared stand before God when our time has come.

Happy Father's Day, Guys! I hope this is a great day for all the men of the parish who are celebrating the role that God has given them, as caretakers of His children. In these difficult times, our young people need strong role models in their fathers. Let us all ask the blessings of God upon all the fathers of St. Jude's. Let us pray that all of them look to the model parenting of St. Joseph as a source of strength, courage, and love; for no father on the earth has had a more important and specific role in God's

divine plan than to care for, raise, and nurture the Son of God. And, for those of us who have already lost our fathers to the Glory of God, keeping close to our hearts those that have lost their Dads since last year, may we offer a prayer of thanksgiving to God for giving us such great men who taught us how to live and how to love. My Dad has been gone for over 25 years now, and even though time has gone by, there isn't a time I don't think of him. For the millionth time, I watched the end of the 1989 movie "Field of Dreams." And, as I have every time, when Kevin Costner realizes that the young "ghost" ballplayer, the last one to leave the field, was his own father, I am reduced to a blubbering fool! All I can think of is my own father. I have watched that movie for 30 years now, and I do that every time!

Many of you may have noticed the new sidewalk on the south side of the Church, where the handicapped parking is. That has recently been completed by Zeolla Construction, and it is the first project as a result of the Catholic Services Appeal. The other two projects remaining this year is the renovation of the Founder's Room and Rectory Offices, as well as the replacement of the Church music books. The CSA is a bit behind last year's at this point. Please, parishioners ... if you have not had the opportunity to make a pledge for the Catholic Services Appeal, please do so as soon as you can! Remember, the responsibility to take care of our properties, and help secure the ministries to those in need, belongs to all of St. Jude's parishioners, *not* just the 30% who have contributed. Please contribute anything that you can!

This week is our annual Emmaus Convocation of Priests. We will be at St. Vincent College in Latrobe all week with our Bishops. Please keep us in your thoughts and prayers. I have enjoyed attending this since 1989, for it is the only time of the year I get to spend some time with many of my brother priests.




