

## From the desk of the Pastor

Today we celebrate the great Feast of “Corpus Christi”, the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ ... the very center and core of the Catholic faith for 2,000 years. In the final week of His life, it was so important

for the Lord to celebrate His final meal with His Apostle *before* He was to be arrested and led off to His crucifixion. Jesus needed to transform the meaning of the Passover. For the 1,200 years before, the Jews would celebrate the Passover in the manner of our “Thanksgiving” and “Fourth of July”. The Jewish Passover was always a feast of thanksgiving and freedom: thankful to the Lord for saving them from the Angel of Death, and for the freedom from slavery to the Egyptians. For all those centuries, a lamb would be the object of the sacrifice at the Passover meal. But, this final meal was to be different. Jesus was going to become the “object of the sacrifice”: He was going to sacrifice Himself so that we could all be freed from our sins and given the chance to rise to a new and eternal life! Thus, the “Lamb of God” would proclaim, *“This IS my Body! This IS my blood! Do this in memory of me!”* For the past twenty centuries, the center and core of the Catholic faith has always been the Word of God AND *His actual presence* given to us in the Body and Blood. On this Feast of Corpus Christi, we celebrate the truth that we are a “Eucharistic-Resurrection” people: *“If you eat my flesh and drink my blood, you will live forever!”* May we always allow the Word of God and the actual presence of Christ be our source of strength and faith in everything we do.

Many people are still very unclear of what our teachings are, regarding Eucharist. First of all, it is so important that we understand and accept the fullness of the truth that the Eucharist IS the actual presence of Jesus Christ. And, with that truth, it is important that we truly reverence the Eucharist. The Church *still* teaches that we need refrain from all foods and drink within ONE HOUR of receiving the Body & Blood of Jesus, except for water or medicine ... unless as order by one’s physician. (That does include gum, breath mints, doughnuts, coffee, and on and on and on! I see way too many people chewing gum during Mass. What do they do? Put their gum on the side of their mouth as they receive the very presence of Jesus in Eucharist?) We *still* teach that, whenever you pass by the Tabernacle, one should bow or genuflect. We *still* teach that, right before one receives the Eucharist, one should make a slight bow. We *still* teach that, when the priest genuflects behind the altar, after raising the host and the cup, the people should offer a significant bow. We *still* teach that, to receive the

Eucharist, you must participate in the Liturgy of the Word; meaning, that if you come to Mass *after* the Gospel, you should not receive the Eucharist. (If you remember, on that mountainside, Jesus only fed the crowd with the fish and bread *after* He nourished them with His Word!) We *still* teach that the Eucharistic celebration is complete *after* the final blessing and closing song. It is just plain wrong, no matter what, to receive the Eucharist, and immediately head for the parking lot. There is no nice way to put it: that is just wrong, no matter what excuse a person can create ... and, I have heard them all! If your house is on fire, I doubt you came to Church that morning with West Lake’s Fire Truck! When it comes to attending a Protestant funeral or wedding, a Catholic *should not* receive their communion, for the Protestant traditions do not believe it to be the “actual presence” of Jesus. And, the non-Catholics *should not* be receiving communion in the Catholic Church, regardless of what their ministers tell them, for the same reason. All these things I share with you as a way to truly help all of us understand, appreciate, and practice a true reverence of the actual presence of Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

I have to tell you that the struggle to visit our parishioners at Hamot and St. Vincent’s is becoming epic. Ever since these corporations took over, they have gone too far in interpreting the laws of privacy. It has been close to 3 years since Hamot has given me a correct listing of parishioners of St. Jude’s. And, because of their priest-less chaplain’s office, they refuse to give us the name of our parishioners over the phone, which would help me verify the list before I drive 6 miles ... find a parking space ... and find out these names are not from St. Jude’s. (Countless times, I find out later that St. Jude’s parishioners were never placed on our list!) I asked a family member of one parishioner to have the nursing supervisor put their loved one’s name on our list. The supervisor’s response? *“That’s not my job.”* And, it isn’t any better at St. Vincent’s. Now, anyone coming through the ER is only listed by religion, *not* by parish. Thank God for Fr. Dennis Martin, SV’s Chaplain. He is our only source of help in finding out who and who is not a parishioner of St. Jude’s. Please, please, please ... have your families inform us if you are in the hospital, and we will do our best to come to see you. It’s getting to the point that family-member-information is our only hope to ministering in our local hospitals.


**St. Jude 31 Club Praying for vocations every day of the year!**






