From the desk of Matt Costa

Today is World Mission Sunday, organized by the Propagation of the Faith, it is a day set aside for Catholics worldwide to recommit to the Church's missionary activity through prayer and giving. As described by Saint John Paul II, it is "an important day in the life of the Church because it teaches how to give: as an offering made to God, in the Eucharistic celebration, for all the missions of the world."

If you want to know what Jesus' parable is about in today's Gospel, we don't need to work too hard because Saint Luke tell us at the beginning: ***"Jesus told his disciples a parable about their need to pray always and not to lose heart."*** I think that we have all said this to encourage someone after some difficulty, disappointment or discouraging moments. This parable brings comfort to us through our prayer life. It is not always easy to listen to this parable though because sometimes we do not see the intentions that we bring in prayer come to fruition in the timely manner we would like to see. I know that it is easy to say that it is God's time not ours. Jesus embraced with great compassion the poor and the marginalized. Could it be that we are also encouraged to pray persistently for the poor, the weak and the vulnerable?

National Alliance on Mental Illness **NAMI** will be here at St. Jude's to present Mental Health First Aid. This is an 8-hour course, so I have scheduled two sessions for this training. The first session is scheduled for Thursday, November 21st

and Friday November 22nd both days starting at 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. The second session is scheduled for Monday, December 2nd starting at 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. lunch will be provided for this day only. For this training to be productive the minimum number is 8 and the maximum is 30. Please RSVP for this training by calling me at the office or by emailing mcosta@stjudeapos.org. This training is helpful for anyone interested in how to help those in need, and especially important to those who volunteer their time at Our Neighbors' Place (the Overflow Shelter).

The evidence behind Mental Health First Aid demonstrates that it makes people feel more comfortable managing a crisis and builds mental health literacy — helping the public identify, understand and respond to signs of mental illness. Specifically, studies found that those who were trained in Mental Health First Aid have greater confidence in providing help to others, greater likelihood of advising people to seek professional help, improved concordance with health professionals about treatments, and decreased stigmatizing attitudes.

St. Jude will host Our Neighbors' Place at The Church of the Nativity 247 East Front Street Wednesday, February 5, 2020 – Wednesday, February 12, 2020. 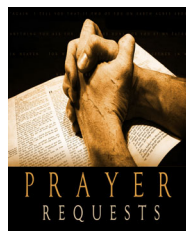

Child Protection and Creating Safe Environments: Bullying Prevention Month:



Relational bullying is unwarranted, persistent, unwelcome behavior in the form of criticism, isolation, or fabricated allegations that can damage relationships. Examples include social exclusion ("You can't be with us"), spreading rumors ("Did you hear...?"), and withholding friendship ("I won't be your friend if you..."). Though relational bullying can often seem ambiguous to outside observers and often garners less attention than physical bullying or verbal bullying, it should not be discounted simply as normal, adolescent behavior. In fact, several recent studies suggest relational bullying is more strongly related to emotional distress and teen depression than any other form of bullying.
