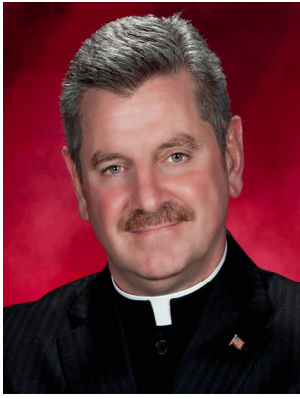

We have been blessed with warm weather so far, so it is going to be gorgeous the next few weeks as the leaves change. 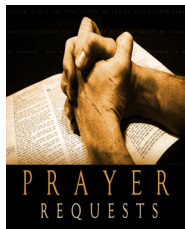


