From the desk of the Pastor

We are now entering the 16th Week of Ordinary Time, with only 18 more weeks before Advent! But, technically, we are only one month into the summer season, where there are

plenty of beautiful and warm weeks left to go outside and enjoy the beauty of God's creation! I am not sure how many people know about this great, little park out off Route 5 in Lake City ... I believe it is called the "Lake City Community Park", just west of the intersection of Route 5 & Rt. 18. I spent several hours out there working on one of my homilies, and it is such a rather quiet place that overlooks the Lake. If you want to try to get away from the busy-ness of the Peninsula for another peaceful place to read or do some work, take a ride out there! The big pavilion is in the center of the park. I didn't realize at first that there was another section to the west of it. Grab a book ... or your rosary beads ... leave your computer at home and your phone in the car and go out and enjoy some peace and prayer!

I write this before our first "Evening with the Pastor", so I am not sure, yet, how it went. But, I am rather excited about it, just for a chance to chat with, and listen to parishioners, just to help with faith, or belief, or their ideas. To be honest, there is a twinge of nervous-ness! I am reminded of this great clip I saw of Johnny Carson, as he hosted his very first show back in October of 1962. He admitted to being nervous, and excited all at the same time, and he looked into the camera and said that the only thing he can think of to say is, "*I want my Nana!*" I should say the same thing! I think it is going to be a very nice evening of just chatting together. I do hope there are lots of young people, too, for I know they have tons of things to ask.

The San Alfonso Clergy Institute is always one of my favorite weeks of the year. I have attending these conferences for the last 17 years, I do believe that it is really good and necessary for us to take a break from our offices and continue our education while fostering our priestly fraternity. We spent the week with three presenters, each spending five sessions with us. It was a very full week! Kathy Galleher, Ph.D. is a psychologist, who

has been working with priests, deacons, and religious for most of her career. Her presentations were entitled, "*AND I WILL GIVE YOU REST: Self Care and Renewal for Ministry*", advising us on how to handle stress and giving us healthy coping responses to it, how to look for signs of "depletion", giving us so much advice on self-awareness and self-care. Fr. Kenneth Himes is a Franciscan priest, and theological ethics professor, and former Chair of the Theology Department for Boston University. He was an awesome presenter! In a very dynamic way, he presented to us on "*Catholic Social Teaching in Contemporary American Life.*" He was showing us that, despite the harsh political divide, and the absolutely crazy rhetoric that goes back and forth between political parties and candidates for office, Democrats and Republicans are rather even in their feelings about the need to care for the poor and for the rights of the human person as a whole, and the rights of the human worker, and how monies should be distributed. Fr. Ciaran O'Callaghan is a Redemptorist priest from Dublin, Ireland, who has taught Scripture for over 25 years. He discovered recently a love to study St. Paul, sharing with us five sessions on "*Proclaiming Christ in a Confused and Uncertain World: St. Paul's Early Preaching*", giving us tremendous insight into the "person" of St. Paul, and so much of his intentions when writing to the Corinthians, Thessalonians, and Galatians particularly. It was fascinating to learn about how influential Paul really became, as well as how he was faced with such resistance at the same time. It really was a phenomenal week! And, it is always great connecting with such great priests that I have come to know over the years. It was rather shocking one night during dinner, when a man obviously on drugs came into the dining room, screaming for a priest who had died years ago ... being chased by several members of the Long Branch Police Department!! It took four of them to bring him into custody, right outside a dining room full of windows!! That's not something you see every day ... at the Jersey Shore!! It did add a little excitement to dinner, though!

It's nice to be back! Have a great week!

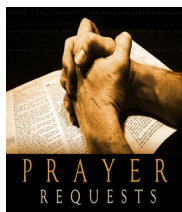


