From the desk of the Pastor

Welcome to our Spaghetti weekend! After many weeks of preparation ... many months of selling tickets ... we have come to the "Serafini's Spaghetti Dinner & Mercedes Raffle"? In fact, this is the 8th Annual, "Serafini Spaghetti Dinner" here at

St. Jude's! We have a great day and an even better dinner ready for everyone over in the St. Jude School gym: homemade meatballs, spaghetti, and the well-known Erie-favorite sauce from Serafini's! The late Tony and Gladys Serafini were founders of the parish, if my memory serves me correctly. And, they used to host spaghetti dinners for St. Jude's back in the '60's, helping to raise money to build the new Church, which was erected in 1971. (That was when Serafini's used to be at north-east corner of West 12th and Lincoln Avenue, for those who remember! That restaurant closed in 1978, and Tony & Gladys opened up the new one in 1979.) We have really enjoyed restoring the St. Jude tradition, with much thanks to Serafini's General Manager, Paula Carrara. And, at the end of this great weekend, we will be raffling off the sought-after **2019 Mercedes AMG C43 Cabriolet**, or \$40,000 in cash!! We've got great theme baskets to win, too! Thank you so much to all the volunteers over there, ready to serve you the best spaghetti in town.

I do want everyone to know that we could never thank our own St. Jude's parishioners enough for the great sacrifices they have made to help us acquire and raffle off these spectacular cars over all these years: this year, George Lyons of Contemporary Motorcar ... David Hallman of Hallman Chevrolet ... Dan McQuillen of McQuillen Auto Group ... and, Mark Winkler of Champion Ford. I could never thank them enough for sacrificing their own profit to help us out at St. Jude's, and giving us all kinds of advice and help. Several occasions, we have needed to borrow trucks or SUVs to take the raffle car from place to place, and they have always been so helpful ... every time. I just want everyone to know, and to keep that in mind the next time you need to purchase your own car!

Monday, October 28th, is the Feast of St. Jude the Apostle! Everyone is invited to morning Mass at 8:00 in the Chapel. But, most importantly, St. Jude School has invited Bishop Lawrence Persico to preside at a special school Mass at 1:45 in the Church. Everyone is more than welcome to come and celebrate our parish feast. Even after all of these centuries, there really isn't very much known about the life of St. Jude, who was also known as "Thaddaeus", from Galilee. He was the Apostle, who at the Last Supper, asked the Lord why He showed Himself

only to the disciples and not to the world. For many centuries, St. Jude was scarcely venerated because so many people confused him with Judas Iscariot. He is the patron saint of lost and desperate causes. According to tradition, St. Jude is believed to have been martyred about 65 A.D. in Beirut. In fact, there is a major shrine to at the "St. Thaddaeus Armenian Monastery in northern Iran. In most depictions of St. Jude, as on the statue of him in the west parking lot, he is seen with a flame above his head, representing his presence at Pentecost, when he received the Holy Spirit with the other Apostles. I just learned that sometime after his death, St. Jude's body was brought from Beirut to Rome, and placed in a crypt in St. Peter's Basilica. His bones are in the left transept of St. Peter's under the main altar of St. Joseph in one tomb with the remains of the Apostle Simon, the Zealot. I wish I knew this when I was at St. Peter's a few years ago! Regardless, Happy Feast Day, St. Jude's! Celebrate with us at morning Mass, or with the Bishop and the School Mass!

This Friday is the Feast of All Saints, and it IS a Holy Day of Obligation. This is the day of the year that we truly honor all those that the Church has recognized to be "saints" because of their devotion to the Lord while living on the earth. And, when you really get the chance to look into so many of their lives, you will realize that so many of them have some backgrounds that are not very different than any one of our own lives. But, regardless of how they "got" to faith, they did! And, they never looked back to their lives without that unbending faith. Normally, on First Fridays, we have adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. But, since it is a Holy Day, with Mass during the day, we will not have Adoration. But, the church will be open all day for prayer. Saturday is the Feast of All Soul's. However, because it falls on a Saturday, we will not be having a special Mass, for the Saturday evening Mass is for the 31st Sunday of Ordinary Time. Next weekend, we will have a display of candles, representing all of the people that were buried from St. Jude's since last All Soul's Day. When you see them, please keep their families in your prayers.

Now that you have read this, get up, and head right over to the Serafini's Spaghetti Dinner! The meatballs are homemade, too! And, you could be driving home in a convertible Mercedes!
