As we start the faith formation year, I wanted to take this opportunity to share some upcoming and exciting events that we are going to be doing this year. I know we all lead busy lives (myself included!) but there are some amazing opportunities that we will be offering, and I want to extend an invitation to our parishioners to attend these events – even if you aren't involved in one of our faith formation programs.

We have youth groups weekly during the school year. Middle school youth group is on Wednesdays from 3-5pm in the school. High school youth group is on Mondays from 6-8pm in the Youth Room.

Today is our first meeting of the 20/30 club for young adults (18+). We will be meeting once a month on Sundays from 2-4pm and discussing issues and topics relevant to this age category. With this group, I want to have a healthy mix of social, spiritual, and service. We will be attending retreats, having group discussion, and participating in service opportunities.

We now have an adult formation class – twice a month on Sundays from 11:30-1:30pm in the Founder's Room – led by Drs. Michael and Kelli DeSanctis. This is an amazing opportunity to learn more about the richness of our Catholic faith. It is also a chance to get caught up if you need to make a sacrament. Schedules can be found in the back of church.

Wednesday, October 2 is our family Project 177 Adoration in the church from 7-9pm. We are bringing in a Catholic recording artist to lead us during this event. Please join us as we usher in the fall season and celebrate the beauty of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament.

Sunday, October 13 we will be attending the Holy Fire Youth Conference in Bowling Green, OH with the Erie Diocese. All middle school (6th-8th grade) students are invited to attend. This is a one-day trip that will allow our middle schoolers to meet other youth from the regional area.

November 21-23 is NCYC (National Catholic Youth Conference). We are taking 9th-12th graders to Indianapolis to experience the faith with 25,000 Catholic youth. This event happens every other year and is a great opportunity for high schoolers to dive deeper into their Catholic faith.

Friday, December 13 will be our annual Follow the Star Christmas concert with Tennessee Backporch. This event will be at 7pm in the church. This has become a wonderful Christmas tradition for many of our St. Jude families and all proceeds from the concert benefit the faith formation program.

In late January, we will be taking a coach bus to the March for Life in Washington D.C. to be a voice for the voiceless. I have many memories of attending this event annually and I'm glad to have the opportunity to share this event with the next generation.

Wednesday, May 13 we will be hosting Chris Stefanick from EWTN's Real Life Catholic. Chris is a great and relatable speaker and I think you will find inspiration in his message. I will have more information on this as we get closer but be sure to save the date and check him out on social media!

June 23-28 will be our trip to the Creation festival in Mount Union, PA. This festival averages between 50,000 to 100,000 each summer for four days of music, praise, and a variety of speakers.

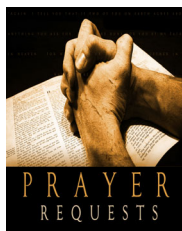


