Rule 2: Practice Silence

This week lets continue to look at the book, *Living Joy: 9 Rules to Help You Rediscover and Live Joy Every Day* by Chris Stefanick. Rule 2 is Practice Silence. Chris tells us, "Silence is the soil where joy grows, because it opens you to gratitude, creates the space for friendship to flourish, allows you to truly rest, and makes prayer possible."

Since the devil is ever at war against finding joy, he has also declared war on silence. Stefanick relates two main temptations against silence:

- <u>Temptation 1: You shall be all knowing.</u> We are tempted to being connected to all information, news flows, and people, all at once. "Take it ALL in!"
- <u>Temptation 2: You shall be all doing.</u> We want to stay on top of all tasks, all at once. To constantly multitask and not focus on one thing at a time. "And the 'noise' of the constant activity kills silence in our hearts."

With technology we can actually become more "disconnected" with those around us.

Quiet time and silence are worth fighting for. "Silence opens us to the presence of something beautiful. Silence is the soil where joy grows." Here are six things that Chris Stefanick says are the fruits of silence:

- 1. <u>Silence and Substance</u> Silence is where our most meaningful work comes from.
- 2. <u>Silence and Wonder</u> We take everything for granted when we get used to it. G.K. Chesterton said that the world is dry, not for lack of wonders, but for lack of wonder.
- 3. <u>Silence and Gratitude</u> Silence leads to reverence. Reverence leads to wonder and awe. Wonder and awe lead to gratitude. Gratitude leads to joy.
- 4. <u>Silence and Your Dreams</u> Silence is the space where dreams grow.

5. <u>Silence and Rest</u> – Rest is necessary for productivity. Your brain even works through problems when you step away from them.

6. <u>Silence and Friendship</u> – Silence creates space where you can really be receptive to another person.

How do we create more silence in our lives. We can do this through four ways:

- 1. <u>Stop. Breathe. Think</u> Find a space to sit and just be quiet. Wherever you are, that's where you are. Don't say a lot of words. Just be in the presence of God.
- 2. <u>Put limits on you screen time</u> Challenge yourself to rest your mind from screens for one day a week. Make it Sunday. Put sway the smart phones during dinner.
- 3. <u>Be bored.</u> Give yourself the space to think, "What now?" And if you don't come up with an answer, do nothing.
- 4. <u>Take walks.</u> Take time each day to walk, even if just for 5 or 10 minutes. Being in nature helps us be in a silent, mindful state.

This is very simple advice. We need to just start so we can grow closer to God and hear his still quiet voice.
