Dear Friends in Christ:

Sometimes things happen we don't expect. Taken by surprise, we can fumble and become victims of our own lack of preparation. If you are having a surgical procedure, the last thing you want to hear in the operating room is "Oops!" What does it mean to 'be prepared'?

St. Paul encouraged the faithful to "Pray always!" Have an ongoing, conscientious communication and positive relationship with God. Think about the presence of the Holy Spirit and reflect on your Guardian Angel's presence as a spiritual friend as well. When an issue comes up, call together these ongoing relationships of spiritual identity to be your 'community of faith' within which you can be successful and optimistic when the challenges of life threaten your personal and spiritual well-being.

When Jesus entered the desert and was tempted three times, His resources included prayer and recollecting spiritual teachings from Sacred Scripture to use as a shield against the Evil One. He had his tools of faith well practiced and arranged for ease of implementing for specific temptations. THAT is being prepared! THAT is being alert! THAT is successfully dispelling the Evil One with the Word of God!

Can you use the tools of Sacred Scripture, Church Teachings, or personal life experiences to offset the Evil One in your life? If not, you're in trouble! Today's Gospel warning is especially aimed at you to read the Word, review Church teaching, practice personal spiritual devotions and discipline so that it becomes 'second nature' to you. Let there be no spiritual "Oopsies" in your life. You have too much to lose – eternal life!
