

Dear Friends in Christ:

This weekend we celebrate "<u>Good Shepherd Sunday</u>." The Good Shepherd is Jesus and Him alone! His Disciples transformed by His grace into Apostles, the Evangelists, Mark, Matthew, Luke and John were graced to 'tell the story' through writing the Gospel accounts, Paul, Peter, John authored Letters (Epistles) to address major issues of spirituality and church management, and Luke narrated the

Acts to describe the success and challenges of the First Century Church formation. Presbyters were appointed to local church groups, and bishops to oversee geographic clusters of churches.

All those groups were led by appointed "shepherds" with leadership expectations. Some were great, others mediocre, some were poor leaders. The same is true of the church leadership today. Every priest, bishop or even 'Holy Father' is made up of strong character credentials as well as deep, spiritual and personal failings. There is only one, truly, "Good Shepherd" and that is Jesus, alone. We are grateful for the opportunity to belong to the Church community of faith. It is here that we connect with the "Mystical Body of Christ." It is here that we receive Sacramental Integrity. When we take each other off the imaginary pedestals and commune as members of the faith-community that we can each do our designated tasks in prayer, solidarity and service.

Each of us have 'shepherding roles' to perform. Parents, grandparents, clergy, religious women, community leaders of specialized groups have special missions the whole community relies on that need to be completed. If everyone does his or her part, then the "common-unity" can be successful. Collectively, the Mystical Body of Christ, the "Good Shepherd" accomplishes its goal...to witness the Gospel.
